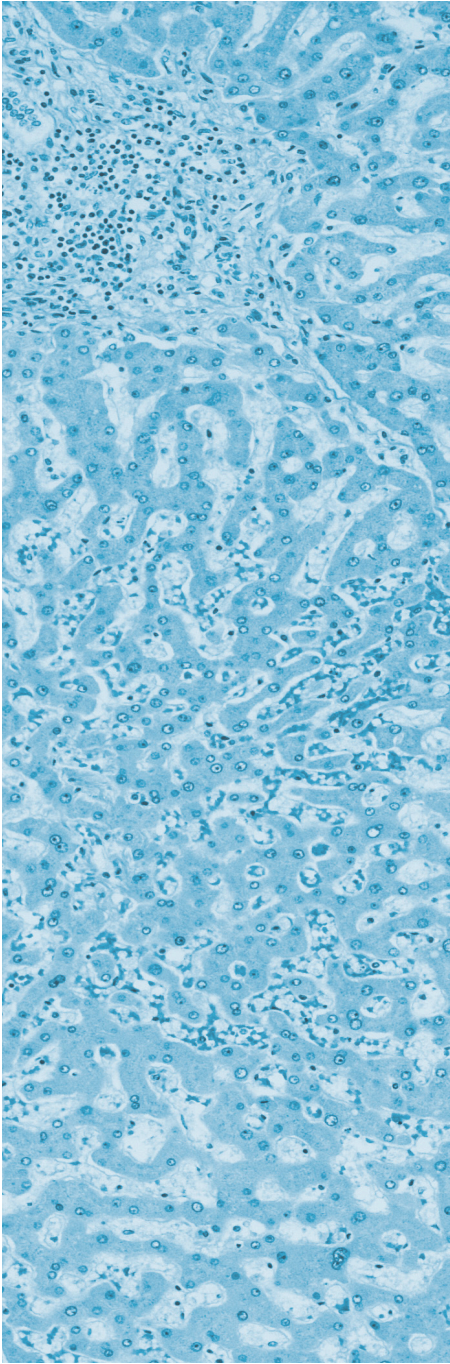

Vitamin A, Alcohol, and the Liver: What's the Link?

Dr. Clugston is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Physiology at the University of Alberta. The lab's major research focus is on the interaction between hepatic vitamin A (retinoid) homeostasis and the pathogenesis of alcoholic liver disease. Alcohol abuse is a major source of morbidity and mortality in Canada, and the primary organ affected by chronic alcohol consumption is the liver. There are significant gaps in our knowledge concerning the initiation and progression of alcoholic liver disease, and we believe that alcohol's effect on hepatic retinoid homeostasis is an underappreciated contributor to its pathogenesis.
