Speaker MacLean opened the meeting with the introduction of our incoming President, Dr. Michael Green.

After an extensive search in 2024, Dr. Green was selected as the successful candidate to be the next NOSM U President, Vice Chancellor Dean and CEO, to begin his term on November 1.

Dr. Green is a family medicine specialist with a notable background, having worked on the James Bay coast. While in Moose Factory, he completed a master's in public health. In 2003, Dr. Green and his family relocated to Kingston, where he began his academic journey at Queen's University, serving as head and professor in the Department of Family Medicine, as well as a professor in Public Health Sciences and Policy Studies, among other roles and accomplishments.

In 2023, Dr. Green was elected as the 70th president of the College of Family Physicians of Canada.
