



Dr. Susan Bradley Scholarship

In Child and Adolescent Psychiatry

The Susan Bradley Scholarship Fund is now receiving applications for a summer 2025 student placement. This student placement is limited to first- and second-year medical students from Canadian universities with an interest in gaining a better understanding and appreciation of child and adolescent psychiatry from clinical and research perspectives.

One scholarship will be awarded to a student who will spend between 7 and 9 weeks attending a variety of clinical opportunities in child & adolescent psychiatry in Toronto, at The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health (CAMH) and The Hospital for Sick Children. Clinical supervision will be provided by a variety of child and adolescent psychiatrists. Exact starting dates will be determined directly with the scholarship winner; however, the scholarship must take place during the summer months of May to August. Scholarships are awarded based upon completion of an application form, academic record, curriculum vitae and one reference letter. You will be contacted if you have been selected for our short list.

The scholarship stipend is \$5,000 for the duration of the scholarship. Students will be required to prepare a summary of their experiences.

Please submit the application form, your up-to-date curriculum vitae and a letter of good standing from your medical school **as one PDF file**. A reference letter (e.g., from a professor or previous employer) is required and should be submitted directly by the referee.
